Here's what we're learning this month:

Peter and Cornelius (ACTS 10-11:18)

Brite Idea: Anyone who believes in Jesus will be saved.

He Question: Is there anyone Jesus does not save?

God wants a relationship with all people. Anyone who believes in Jesus will be saved, but Jesus gives us the choice. Believing in Him is the only way we can be saved.

Memory Verse: Everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins through His name. **Acts 10:43b**

We Question: How can we welcome all people the way God does?

Our sin can lead us to treat people worse because they are different from us. We can welcome people like God does by not playing favorites and sharing about Jesus even with people who look or think differently from us.

Peter Rescued From Prison (ACTS 12:1-18)

Brite Idea: God's plan always wins.

He Question: What is God's plan?

We won't always know the specific details of God's plan, but the great purpose of God's plan is to one day fix the broken world we live in. All believers in Jesus will live forever with Him in the new heaven and new earth.

Memory Verse: The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save. **Zephaniah 3:17a**

We Question: Does God always rescue His people from hard times?

Because Jesus made a way for us to be saved, we can know that even if we have hard times, His promises remain true. He will be faithful until the end.

Lydia (ACTS 16:6-15)

Brite Idea: God chooses to work through people.

He Question: Does God only work through certain people?

God doesn't have favorite people that He works through while ignoring the rest. He wants to work through all people. He gives us all opportunities to follow where He is leading. As we grow closer to Him, we see those opportunities more clearly.

Memory Verse: For it is God who works in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure. **Philippians 2:13**

We Question: How can God work through us?

God works through us when we follow the wisdom He gives us. When we show love and speak the truth about Jesus, we help people to know God.

Priscilla, Aquila, and Apollos (ACTS 18:18-28)

Brite Idea: God's wisdom helps us grow.

He Question: How does God give His wisdom to us?









The main source of God's wisdom that He has given us is His Word, The Bible. He also gives us wisdom through wise teachers and prayer.

Memory Verse: For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding. **Proverbs 2:6**

We Question: How can followers of Jesus help each other grow?
