THE TWELVE SCOUTS (NUMBERS 13-14)

Nov 2

Brite Idea: God is trustworthy.

Memory Verse: For we walk by faith, not by sight. **2 Corinthians 5:7**

He Question: Can we believe what God says?

We Question: How do we show that we trust God?

We can trust God 100% of the time because He is good, He loves us, and He is in control.

We show that we trust God by doing what He says and living life His way.

JOSHUA DIVIDES THE LAND (JOSHUA 13-21)

Nov 9

Brite Idea: God does what He says.

Memory Verse: God is not man, that He should lie, or a son of man, that He should change His mind. **Numbers 23:19a**

He Question: Does God ever change His mind?

We Question: What does God promise us?

When God promises something, He never breaks His promise. There are times He shows grace to people while staying true to who He is.

The Bible is filled with God's promises for us, including that He is always with us, He loves us, and He forgives us.

GIDEON (JUDGES 6-7)

Nov 16

Brite Idea: God works in unlikely ways.

Memory Verse: For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways, declares the Lord. **Isaiah 55:8**

He Question: Does God know what He's doing?

We Question: What if we don't like what God is doing?

God is in control of all things and knows all things. He always does what is best.

We as humans can't understand everything about God and His ways. Our understanding is limited, but His is not. Even when we don't understand we can trust that He knows best.

NAOMI (RUTH 1)

Nov 30, Part 1

Brite Idea: God is with me when I'm hurting.

Memory Verse: The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit. **Psalms 34:18**

He Question: Why doesn't God always stop sad things?

We Question: Is it ok for us to be sad when bad things happen?

There will always be sad things that happen because our world is broken by sin. God uses sad things in our lives to bring us closer to Him.

God gave us all of our emotions. It is perfectly normal to be sad, but we can still have hope because God is with us.

RUTH AND BOAZ (RUTH 2-4)

Nov 30, Part 2

Brite Idea: God knows our future.

Memory Verse: But I trust in You, O Lord; I say, "You are my God." My times are in Your hand. **Psalms 31:14-15a**










He Question: Is everything that happens part of God's future plan?

We Question: How do we know what God wants us to do?

God is in control of everything. Everything that happens in our lives is part of His bigger plan of redeeming and restoring His people.

The Holy Spirit leads us, teaches us, and shows us what is right and wrong. The Bible teaches us how God says life works best.
